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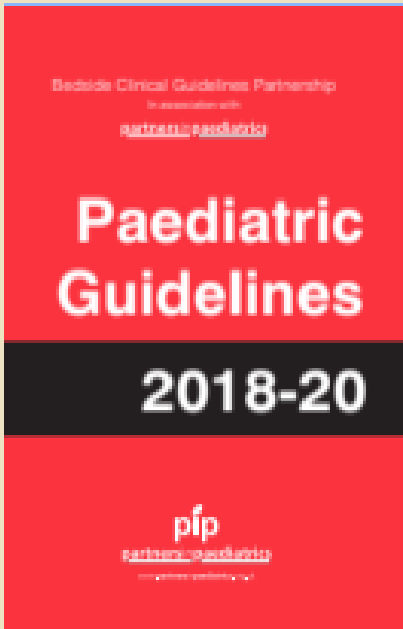

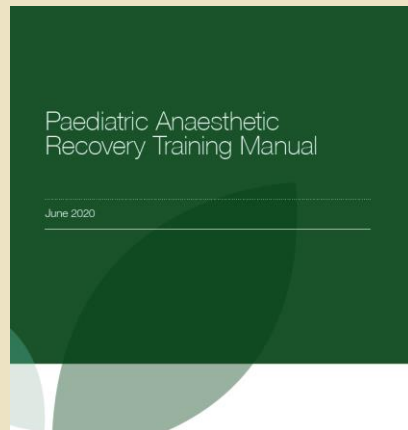


Paediatric Guidelines

Following many years of work the Paediatric Anaesthetic Network are delighted to launch the publication of the PART Manual. The manual, along with the Skills Outcome Booklet will be circulated across all of our member trust over the next few weeks.



Education

As well as supporting our networks we continue to support education within our Networks and beyond.

Throughout the last year we were approached by three new forums to support education sessions, The Neurology Forum and the General Paediatric Forum both held various successful study days. All of the events were well attended and feedback received shows an appetite for further sessions. We are also working with colleagues within Metabolic disorders to host their 'Metabolic Emergencies Study day' in the near future.

Collaborations

This year has seen PiP strengthen its collaboration with other partners across the region, this has included the West Midlands Critical Care Network (WMPCCN), with a joint project to improve services for the children and young people on a Long Term Ventilation pathway.

Our firm association with University of Birmingham, City of Birmingham University and Worcester University has seen the development of a 'Paediatric Nurse Education Forum'. We aim to move this forward during 21/22 as well as the development of a Student Nurse Forum with their support.
